

## **FRASERBURGH WALK – 5**

5 MILES APPROX - **‘ALONG THE BEACH’** - 2 HOURS APPROX

1. Start at the Leisure Centre and head towards the town Centre along Seaforth Street. Turn right down Station Brae, then right onto South Harbour Road. Continue on then turn left onto the Esplanade and the caravan Park.
2. Just after the caravan park an opening in the railings leads down the steps onto a concrete path. Continue along following slipway down to the beach. Cross over the burn and continue along the beach.
3. Continue along until the River Philorth at the rear end of the beach. Cross over the burn and continue along the beach.
4. Follow the walkway over the dunes, coming back to the beach at a wooden post and lifebuoy box. Continue to the left back along the beach towards Fraserburgh. On reaching the wooden fencing, take the first walkway to the left and carry on up the wooden steps to the top of the dunes.
5. Continue down the other side (straight ahead is the cycle path). Carry on to the right and just after a house, turn left onto a short track leading onto the B9033 St Combs road passing the cemetery on the left. At the junction cross over South Road take care as this is a very busy road.
6. Carry on along the track straight ahead, which leads to Maconachie Road. Turn right onto Maconachie Road which leads onto Saltoun Place. Turn right onto Victoria Street then first right onto Seaforth Street returning to the leisure centre.
